

## Right to ask questions

Shareholders, holders of subscription rights and holders of debentures<sup>1</sup> may ask written questions to the Board of Directors and to the Statutory Auditor ahead of the Annual General Meeting of 11 May 2022 by notifying such questions to NV Bekaert SA **no later than Thursday 5 May 2022**.

A timely asked written question will be answered at the Annual General Meeting of 11 May 2022:

- if the question relates to the agenda items of the Annual General Meeting;
- to the extent that communication of data or facts would not cause damage to NV Bekaert SA or breach any confidentiality commitments made by NV Bekaert SA or its Directors; and
- if the securities of the shareholder, holder of subscription rights or holder of debentures¹ asking the question, are registered in his/her name on the record date of **Wednesday 27 April 2022**, and if the shareholder, holder of subscription rights or holder of debentures¹ notifies NV Bekaert SA **no later than Thursday 5 May 2022** that he/she wishes to attend the Annual General Meeting.

A question asked at the Annual General Meeting will be answered subject to the same conditions.
