## Description of the project

Kolumba is the art museum of the archbishopric of Cologne. As bonded construction of facing masonry on the one hand and clay bricks or concrete on the other hand, it requests the designer to take stresses into account arising from: restraint deformation, differential temperature, settlement, shrinkage and creep

The visitor can experience a jointless construction, built with technologies from late antiquity to the present. More than 70,000m Murfor were supplied by an Bekaert authorized dealer.
